



TROPIC SHORES UNIT - 1

AND BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS: From the Northern Corner of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 3, Township 26, Range 16, Pasco County, Florida, run S 85° 23' 45" W 872.58 ft. to the Point of Beginning, thence S 0° 05' 31" W 532.05 ft.; thence N 63° 00' 04" W 622.05 ft.; thence N 21° 53' 55" E 20 ft.; thence N 10° 05' 31" E 231.60 ft.; thence by a curve to the right, radius 163 ft., arc 73.81 ft., chord N 14° 10' 31" E 73.38 ft.; thence N 29° 35' 31" E 240 ft.; thence N 88° 22' 00" E 200 ft.; thence S 83° 05' 55" E 244.06 ft.; thence N 10° W 66 ft.; thence by a curve to the right, radius 40 ft., arc 115.72 ft., chord S 2° 50' 15" W 70.36 ft. to the Point of Beginning.
