


SHAMROCK HEIGHTS UNIT FOUR

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 17, Township 26S, Range 16E, Pasco County, Florida; thence run along the West line of said Section 17, NO° 23 26° E., 222 ft. to the North right of way line of State Road No. 536, thence along said right of way line N 89° 45' 45" W., 25 ft. to a Point of Beginning; thence NO° 23 26° E., 100 ft.; thence N 89° 45' 45" E., 50 ft.; thence NO° 21 48° E., 300 ft.; thence N 89° 45' 45" W., 100 ft.; thence NO° 21 48° E., 120 ft.; thence NO° 23 26° E., 133.35 ft.; thence N 89° 45' 45" W., 84.38 ft. to the East Right of Way line of U.S. Highway 19; thence along said right of way line N 89° 45' 45" E., 50 ft.; thence N 89° 45' 45" W., 300 ft.; thence N 89° 45' 45" E., 100 ft.; thence N 89° 45' 45" W., 20.66 ft. to the Point of Beginning.


