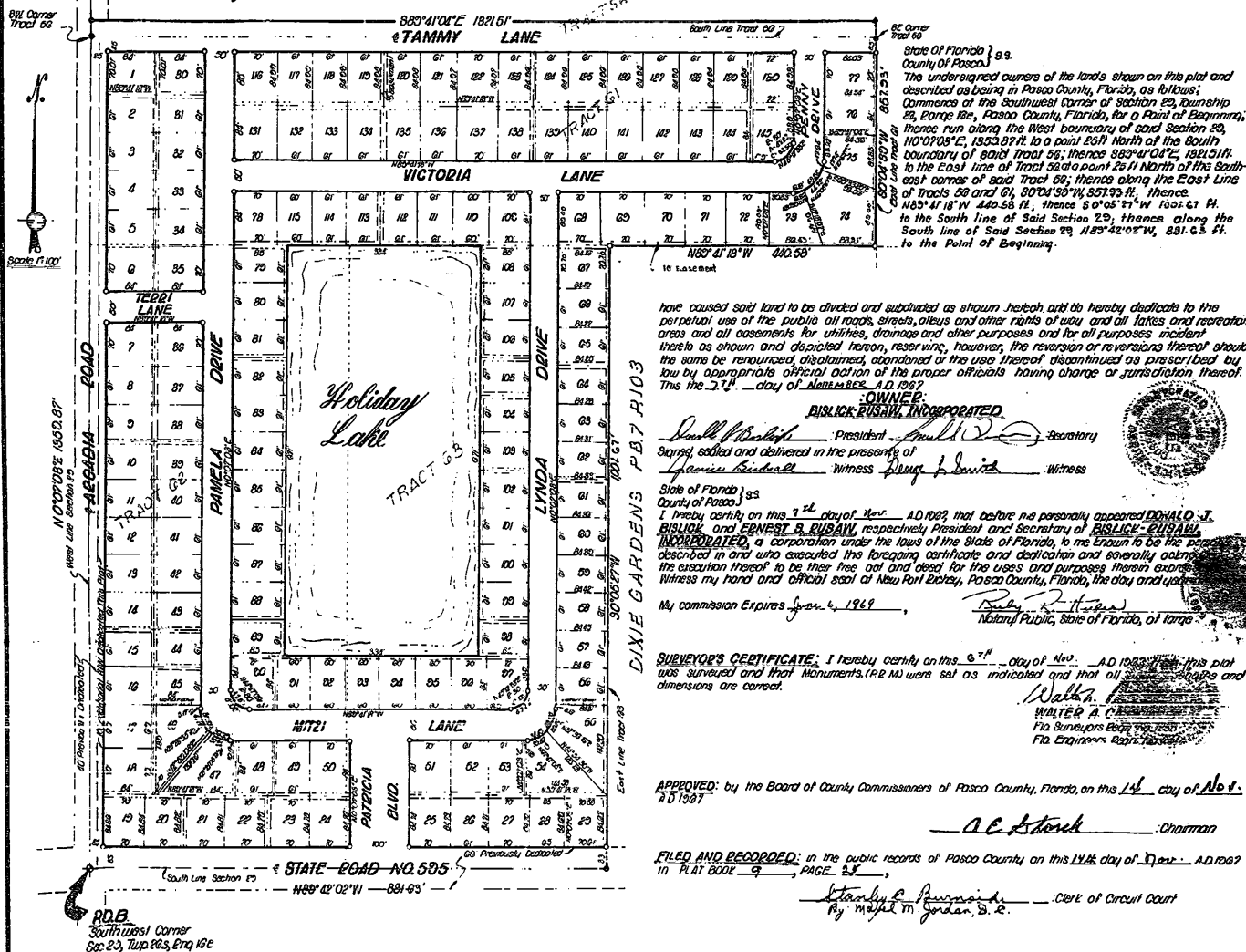


HOLIDAY GARDENS UNIT ONE

The undersigned owners of the lands shown on this plat and described as being in Pasco County, Florida, as follows: Commences at the Southwest Corner of Section 29, Township 28 S, Range 16 E, Pasco County, Florida, for a Point of Beginning, thence run along the West boundary of said Section 29, N0°07'05"E, 1353.87 ft. to a point 26 ft. North of the South boundary of said Tract 56; thence S83°41'04"E, 1921.5 ft. to the East line of Tract 56 at a point 25 ft. North of the South-east corner of said Tract 56; thence along the East line of Tracts 56 and 61, S0°04'35"W, 557.93 ft.; thence N85°41'18"W 440.58 ft.; thence S0°05'11"W 1002.61 ft. to the South line of said Section 29; thence along the South line of said Section 29, N83°42'02"W, 831.65 ft. to the Point of Beginning.
