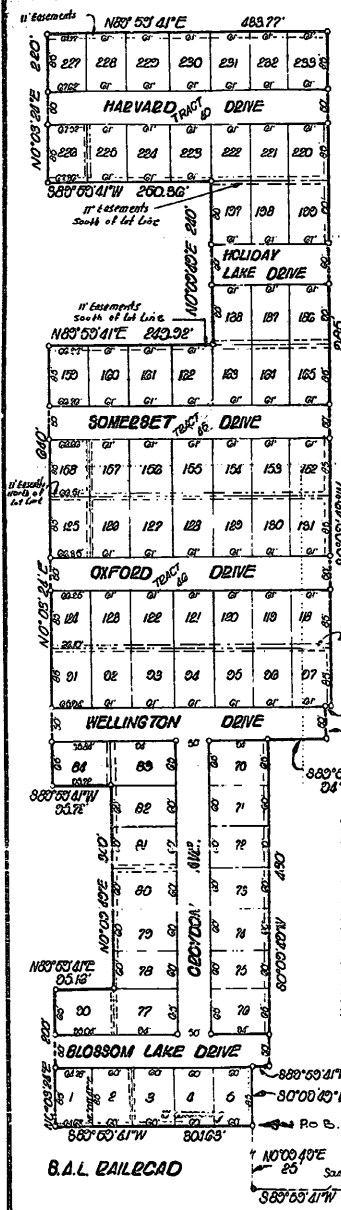


HOLIDAY LAKE ESTATES - UNIT FOUR
