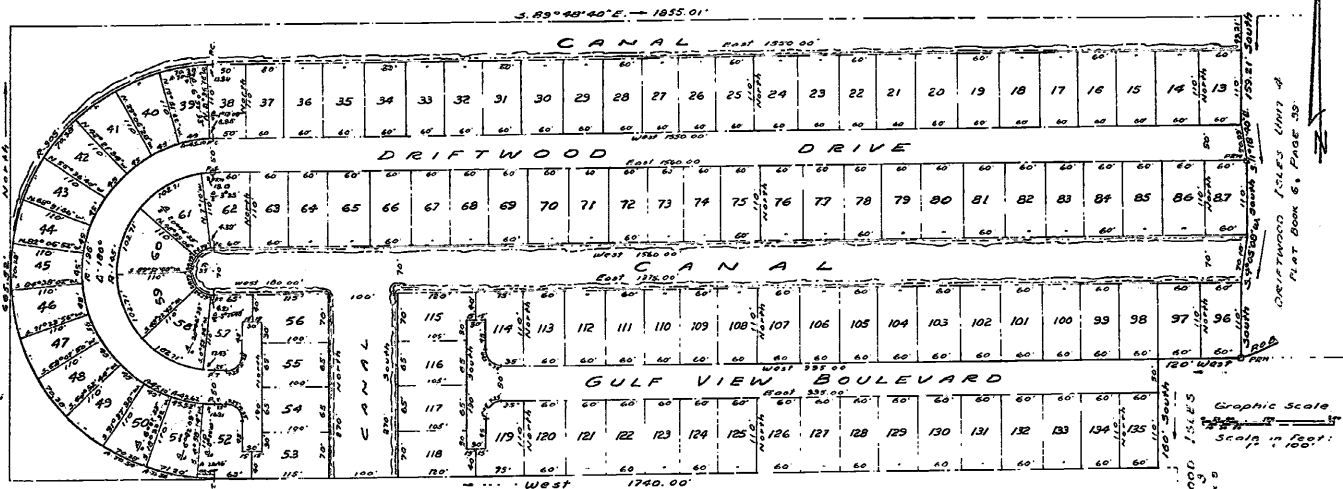


DRIFTWOOD ISLES **UNIT NO. 5**

DESCRIPTION:

Being a subdivision of a part of the northeast quarter of Section 28, Township 24 South, Range 16 East, in Pasco County, Florida; and being more particularly described as follows: Begin at the southwest corner of lot 95, Driftwood Isles Unit 4, as recorded in Plat Book 6, page 39, of the public records of Pasco County, Florida; run thence west, 120 feet; thence south, 160 feet; thence east, 1740.00 feet; thence north, 665.50 feet; thence S. 40° 46' 42" E., 1855.01 feet; thence south, 129.71 feet; thence S. 11° 18' 40" E., 50.95 feet; thence south, 110 feet; thence S. 4° 06' 30" E., 70.16 feet; thence south, 110 feet, to the lot of Septimia.
