A house in town gives you the convenience of stores, railroads, post-office, churches, schools; amusements, the companionship of close neighbors, and the society of friends.


Only a limited number of town lots will be included free with each purchase of a ten-acre tract. These will go to the first purchasers of our lands, and will all soon be allotted.
