The undersigned owners and mortgagees of the lands shown on this plat and described as being in Pasco County, Florida, as follows;

Commence at the Southwest corner of Section 29, Township 26S, Range 18E, Pasco County, Florida; thence run along the West boundary of Section 29, N0°03'50"W, 822.37 ft. for a Point of Beginning; thence continue N0°03'53"W, 674.5 ft.; thence 101.17 ft. along the arc of a curve to the left to the most Southerly corner of Lot 28 of Harbor Isles Subdivision as shown on Plat recorded in Plat Book 8, Pages 35 and 36 of the Public Records of Pasco County, Florida; said curve having a radius of 831.61 ft. and a chord of 101.10 ft. which bears N02°08'28"W; thence along the Southeast boundary of said Lot 28, N93°32'27"E, 145.70 ft. to the most Northerly corner of Lot 29 of said Harbor Isles Subdivision; thence S44°02'20"E, 110.80 ft.; thence S38°27'07"E, 161.04 ft.; thence S37°05'42"E, 150.18 ft.; thence S68°50'06"E, 127.70 ft.; thence S19°04'40"E, 280 ft.; thence S77°01'22"W, 125 ft.; thence 122.05 ft. along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 16 ft. and a chord of 82.38 ft. which bears S68°01'10"W; thence 108.54 ft. along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 88 ft. and a chord of 122.90 ft. which bears N31°20'13"W; thence N40°18'16"W, 303 ft.; thence 82.18 ft. along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 376 ft. and a chord of 62.11 ft. which bears N35°31'15"W; thence 62.28 ft. along the arc of a curve to the left to the Point of Beginning, said curve having a radius of 225 ft. and a chord 82.65 ft. which bears N88°31'16"W.


